Emeritus Status Policy & Procedure

Policy

As at January 2021, the Australian and New Zealand Board of Perfusion wish to recognise those retired perfusionists with a long-standing career by categorising them as Certified Clinical Perfusionist Emeritus (CCP Emeritus). This category was approved at the Australian and New Zealand College of Perfusion AGM in November 2020. Any CCP (ANZ) who satisfies the following criteria may apply:

1. The retiring CCP must apply to the Board with a letter detailing their career, including twenty (20) or more cumulative years of experience as a CCP in good standing. This request for CCP Emeritus status should be received within 12 months of losing certification.
2. The applicant must agree to use the title CCP Emeritus and not to use the title, CCP Aust or CCP (ANZ).
3. The applicant must maintain a current mailing/email address on file with the ANZCP.
4. The applicant must sign an Emeritus Status Acknowledgement Form to forego their recertification. Upon receiving the acknowledgement form, being approved by the ANZBP and ratified by ANZCP Executive, the ANZCP Registrar will place the individual in the CCP Emeritus status.

Once the CCP Emeritus status is conferred, the applicants' name will be published on the ANZCP website under the CCP Emeritus Registry with the title of CCP Emeritus. They will be provided with a certificate recognizing their service as a CCP.

There is no fee associated with this status as it is done only once.

If the CCP Emeritus wishes to come out of retirement and practice perfusion, the ANZBP recertification requirements will need to be met prior to the CCP (ANZ) being granted.

Procedure

1. The applicant is to email their application forms as well as a letter detailing their career to support their application for Emeritus status, to abcpsec@anzcp.org and cc'd to admin@anzcp.org with the subject as Emeritus Application.
2. The Board will discuss the application and respond within 60 days of receiving.
3. If successful, a letter and certificate from the ANZBP will be issued to the CCP Emeritus;
4. The applicant will be added to the CCP Emeritus Registry on the ANZCP website.
