Dr Sarah Scheuer is currently a Cardiothoracic Surgery Trainee at the Alfred Hospital in Melbourne. However, prior to commencing her formal training, she undertook a PhD at the Victor Chang Cardiac Research Institute and St Vincent's Hospital, Sydney. Her PhD focussed on donor heart preservation, including the prevention of myocardial ischaemic reperfusion injury and the ex-situ perfusion of donor organs. Much of her work has focused on the use of donation after circulatory death (DCD) donors for heart transplantation, first performed at St Vincent's, Sydney but now rapidly expanding throughout the northern hemisphere.
