W. Scott Snider is a staff perfusionist in the adult perfusion services department at Duke University Health Systems in Durham, North Carolina, USA. He is a 1996 graduate of the Texas Heart Institute who has served thirteen years as Board Director, Treasurer, President-Elect and President of American Society of Extracorporeal Technology (AmSECT). He is currently serving as a Senior Advisor at Large to the AmSECT Board of Directors, as well as its International Ambassador.

Scott is the Chairman of the AmSECT committee Perfusion Without Borders, a founding member of the AmSECT Safety committee, and Chair of the AmSECT Centers of Excellence Review Committee. He is actively involved with the cardiac surgical missions group CardioStart, as former Chair of its planning and standards oversight committee and liaison to its Board of Directors.

Throughout his career, Scott has been a passionate advocate for advancing perfusion through quality improvement, patient safety, education and international collaboration. His leadership has helped shape initiatives including the development of AmSECT's Perfusion Centers of Excellence program and broader efforts to promote evidence-based standards and a strong culture of safety across the profession.

Drawing on his experience at Duke University Hospital - one of the largest and most respected perfusion programs in the United States - and decades of leadership within AmSECT, Scott brings a practical, global perspective on the future of perfusion practice that will resonate with clinicians across Australia and New Zealand.
